



Chelsea Jewish Lifecare continues to do everything we can to protect the health and safety of our residents and staff and prevent the spread of COVID-19. We strictly follow all MA DPH, CDC, and other state and federal regulations to maintain effective infection control. These measures include but are not limited to:

- Daily monitoring and screening of residents and staff for signs of an infection including several temperature checks throughout the day
- A restrictive family outdoor visitation policy for residents who have never been infected or have recovered from COVID-19
- Universal mask protocol for all staff while working in the facility
- Additional staff training and frequent audits to ensure adherence of up to date infection control practices
- In-room delivery of meals
- Cancellation of group events and closure of communal spaces
- Asking non-essential employees to work from home to limit exposure

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) supply and usage are monitored daily. We have a standard process for procuring our own PPE and have a stable source of at least 2 weeks of PPE supply across all PPE items including facemasks, respirators, gowns, gloves, and eye protection.

Testing

Broad scale testing continues for all our residents and staff in each facility and is an important component of our strategy to protect the health and safety of our residents and staff. Residents who test positive, regardless of symptoms, are quarantined and cared for by a separate and dedicated team in an isolation unit or a private apartment. All employees who test positive, regardless of symptoms, are quarantined at home for a minimum of 10 days. The numbers below represent the current impact of COVID-19 in our sites.
